## Letter from the director


Dear friends of Youth Programs,

## Highlights from 2006

### Improved campus chapter application process

The Youth Programs department took a brief hiatus from chartering campus chapters in 2005–2006 in order to re-evaluate the application process. As a result, a process that used to take nine to 12 months to complete can now be completed in two to three months. This streamlined process will result in more chapters chartered and will allow Campus Chapter coordinators more time and energy to devote toward supporting existing chapters.

### General Mills-sponsored Collegiate Challenge trips to the Gulf Coast

Due to a generous donation from General Mills, the Youth Programs department is able to coordinate three Collegiate Challenge trips to help rebuild in the Gulf Coast. The teams are made up of 25 individuals, ages 18 to 25. The first of these trips took place from July 12 to 22, 2006. The participants toured the destruction, learned about the poverty situation in both pre- and post-Katrina New Orleans and met with displaced homeowners. The group then traveled to Thibodaux, La., where they helped, along with the partner families, build homes that would house hurricane-affected families. The next two trips are scheduled to take place in the winter of 2006 and the spring of 2007.

### Youth United DVD

Another great resource that has resulted from a generous donation from the Argosy Foundation is the Youth United DVD. In May 2006, this resource became available to all Habitat affiliates and campus chapters. Created with a youth audience in mind, the DVD is an excellent tool for affiliates to use in recruiting youth.

### Habitat on the Hill

Students from the Washington, D.C. area participated in “Habitat on the Hill,” a day-long event—sponsored by the Youth Programs department and the Office of Government Relations—that included an advocacy workshop, appointments with members of Congress, and training sessions with substandard housing experts. Students dialogued with a panel which consisted of Habitat for Humanity International’s director of Government Relations, Habitat for Humanity International’s senior director of International Communications and Advocacy, a representative from the ONE Campaign, and a legislative assistant to Rep. Mark Green of Wisconsin. The Act! Speak! Build! advocacy workshop concluded with an explanation of Habitat for Humanity’s federal legislative priorities to the students before they left for their congressional visits. (Taken from “Act! # Department Programs

## Act! Speak! Build! Week

### Tools for Advocacy

Youth continue to have a leading role in Habitat for Humanity’s advocacy efforts. This year has raised student advocacy effectiveness to new heights with increased participation in Act! Speak! Build! Week, additional resources and innovative events worldwide.

### Act! Speak! Build! Week 2006

Date: April 3–9

Theme: Poverty Knows No Borders

This year was the first that participation was opened to groups of youth that are not campus chapters. Nearly 15 percent of those participating were comprised of entities such as scout troops, service organizations, student governments and religious youth groups. Expanding participation underlines the realization that Habitat must look outside of the organization to advocate in an effective way. As Habitat’s Advocacy Task Force states: “Advocacy is about partnerships. One voice alone is not nearly as effective as a chorus of voices speaking out for change.”

### Our Towns Youth United

Our Towns Youth United program partnered locally with Davidson College to expand their Act! Speak! Build! Week activities and involve all ages 5 to 25. Davidson College planned extensively and Our Towns Youth United joined and supplemented some of their efforts. One of the events was a letter-writing campaign, after which affiliate staff members were able to meet with Elizabeth Dole and present the letters to her in person. Another event was a shantytown that featured campout time during that day so younger ages could participate in awareness activities, as well.

*Act! Speak! Build! Week is Habitat for Humanity’s worldwide week of student advocacy for affordable housing. Student groups partner with local Habitat affiliates to plan and implement activities such as speaker panels, rallies and letter-writing campaigns.*

### Act! Speak! Build! Week Award

Rookie of the Year: Troy University

The Troy University Campus Chapter implemented a week of advocacy events that included a visit from their local state senator, media coverage, a sleepout, a fact campaign and a pledge drive for missing a meal—all in their first year of Act! Speak! Build! Week participation! Troy University also implemented two campaign events: the Prayer for an End to Poverty Housing, which was organized as a candlelight vigil, and the Letter-writing Campaign, in which students at the sleepout used the letter-writing templates provided by Habitat. They stated that working closely with their affiliate, Troy-Pike HFH, and involving local media contributed to the success of their events.

## Campus Chapters

### Tools for Accomplishment

Campus chapters have once again made their mark in the fight against substandard housing. As of the summer of 2006, there are approximately 600 campus chapters playing an active role in the ministry of Habitat for Humanity.

*Habitat for Humanity campus chapters are student-initiated, student-run groups on high school and college campuses that partner with their local Habitat for Humanity affiliates. Campus chapters seek to eliminate poverty housing through building and refurbishing homes, raising funds for the work of Habitat for Humanity, educating their local communities about Habitat for Humanity and advocating for an end to substandard housing.*

### Tools for Change

A number of changes were implemented at the national level to strengthen the foundation of our campus chapter program and enable an even greater impact in years to come.

These changes have been implemented to allow HFHI to provide better service to our campus chapters as well as enable campus chapters to make an even greater impact in years to come. Highlights include:

- **Revised Campus Chapters Operations Manual** – Many hours went into compiling the most crucial information for operating a successful campus chapter into one handy resource. In the fall of 2006, all chapters will have this revised tool to reference as they make choices and plans in carrying out the mission.
- **The online Annual Report** –The annual reporting process was streamlined and made available via online access for the first time. This new tool makes it simpler for campus chapters to report their accomplishments. It also provides better, more timely data to Habitat for Humanity. In addition, the online system automatically forwards the annual report to the chapter's partner affiliate and requires the affiliate to review and approve the information. This enhancement increases cooperation among chapters and the partner affiliate in their local area.
- **Enhanced services and support** –The Youth Programs department examined many ways to improve the support offered to campus chapters. In the fall of 2006 chapters will have access to many updated resources, a redesigned Web site, topic-specific conference calls, the ability to apply for specialized training with a Youth Programs consultant, and the opportunity to apply for matching grants through the Youth Programs department.

### In the past year, campus chapters:

- Raised over **\$3.5 million** for Habitat for Humanity.
- Donated over **\$1.1 million** to their local affiliate partners.
- Sponsored or cosponsored **44** Habitat for Humanity homes.
- Sent **\$73,000** to international Habitat for Humanity affiliates through the Tithe Program.
- Raised **\$1.2 million** for Collegiate Challenge building trips in the United States.
- Raised **\$260,000** for Global Village international building trips.
- Engaged **34,000** youth as members of Campus Chapters in the United States.

#### **Campus Chapter Profile: Washington and Lee University**

The Washington and Lee University campus chapter in Lexington, Va., has set a goal to cosponsor a Habitat for Humanity house every year with Rockbridge Area Habitat for Humanity. This past year, they donated \$21,000 toward the house sponsorship and faithfully volunteered with the local affiliate. They are extremely ambitious and innovative in their fund-raising efforts. Each fall they host a Habitat Hotel, which raised \$11,000 this year alone! The “hotel” takes place during Parent’s Weekend as families stay in local homes and donate \$100 per night to the chapter. In addition to raising funds, families in the homes have an opportunity to learn more about the ministry of Habitat for Humanity.

#### **Campus Chapter Profile: The Ohio State University**

The campus chapter at The Ohio State University had another impressive year, making an impact both in the United States and throughout the world. The chapter sent two separate teams of students to Slidell, La., to help clean up and rebuild from the devastation brought by Hurricane Katrina. In all, 150 students and faculty made the 16-hour journey to bring hope to the people rebuilding from this natural disaster. In addition, the campus chapter participated in five additional domestic Collegiate Challenge trips. They also sent Global Village work teams to Honduras, Argentina, and Romania. During the 2005–2006 school year the chapter raised over \$137,000 and donated well over 8,000 hours of volunteer student labor!

### Tools for Compassion

After Hurricanes Katrina and Rita devastated much of the Gulf Coast in August of 2005, many students contacted the Collegiate Challenge team hoping to spend their school breaks helping with Habitat's rebuilding efforts. In spite of facing enormous challenges, some host affiliates in the Gulf Coast were able to host Collegiate Challenge teams throughout 2006. As a result, 1,463 students spent their school breaks working to help Habitat rebuild in the Gulf Coast.

### Tools for Technology

Students talked and we listened. In response to suggestions from participating student groups, Collegiate Challenge introduced an online registration system in the fall of 2005 for Spring Break participants. The process revolutionized student registration and allowed group leaders to register groups more quickly and efficiently. Group leaders were also able to log in and view pertinent trip information and updates. This advancement was taken a step further in the winter of 2006 when an online system for requesting fall, winter and summer break trips was added to the Web site.

Collegiate Challenge is a multi-faceted program with many goals and potential outcomes. Many of these goals center on educating participants and giving them the tools they need to become more involved volunteers, leaders and citizens.

#### Leadership Skills

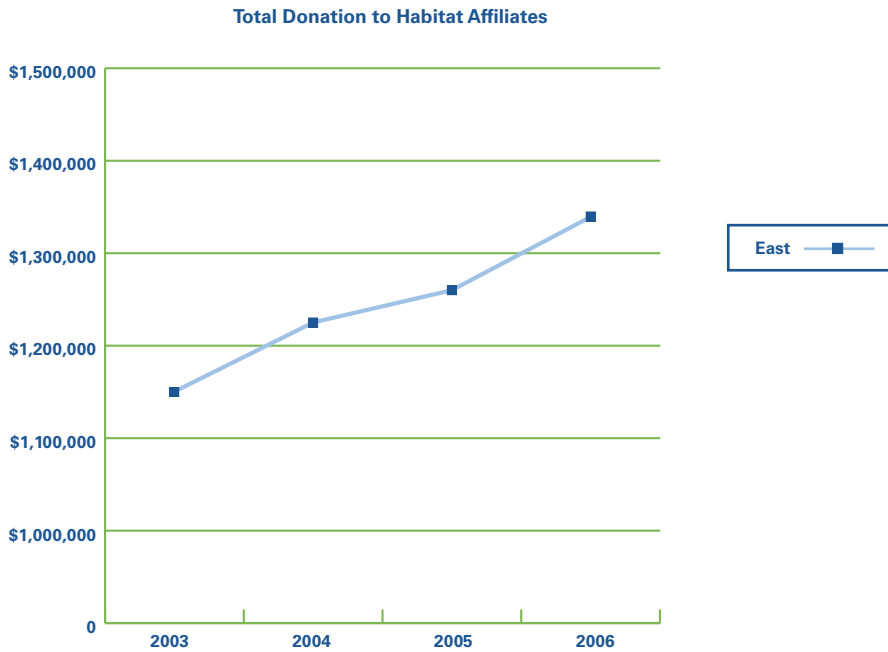
Currently, the majority of trips are student-organized and student-led. In addition to building during their school break, these student leaders register, confirm, fund and facilitate their teams. The Collegiate Challenge team provides resources such as the Collegiate Challenge Leader Guide to aid these student leaders.

An important focus of the Collegiate Challenge program is to inspire students to begin a lifelong dedication to volunteering and service to their communities. The meaningful work and new experiences students encounter during their Collegiate Challenge trip often motivate them to continue working with Habitat for Humanity and like-minded organizations throughout their educational and professional careers.

#### Participant Enrichment

Students, parents, youth group leaders, and the general public can learn more about Collegiate Challenge on the Youth Programs Web site, [www.habitatyouthprograms.org](http://www.habitatyouthprograms.org). Additionally, participants and group leaders receive





program publications that focus on educating them about poverty housing and the mission of Habitat for Humanity, while at the same time preparing them and setting expectations for their experience. Christian youth groups also received “Faith Builders,” a faith-based supplement for high school students, designed to encourage spiritual growth throughout the Collegiate Challenge experience.

*Preparing Host Affiliates*

The heart of the Collegiate Challenge program lies with the host affiliate. In an effort to better prepare affiliates for the challenges of hosting student groups, the Collegiate Challenge team has reevaluated and upgraded the information available to affiliates. New materials include Best Practices, templates and advice on vital hosting practices.

### Tools for Global Awareness

On June 22, 100 students descended on the community of Wallacedene in Cape Town, South Africa, for the International Student Build 2006. They arrived from Northern Ireland, South Africa, the Netherlands, Kenya, Uganda, Canada and the United States, enthusiastic students from wildly different countries and perspectives. The only thing they had in common was their desire to help another human being, a stranger, to achieve the dream of a lifetime.

In the space of a week, 100 strangers became friends for life as they mixed dhagga (mortar), lifted bricks and nailed on tiles. Beautiful sunny weather meant building moved quickly, leaving plenty of time for face painting and wild soccer matches in the streets with the neighborhood children. African drumming, traditional South African braai's (barbeques) and an International Evening ensured evenings were just as much fun as the day's building.

By the end of the week, the glass was gleaming in the windows and the walls had been smoothed and dried. Students and community members stood arm in arm and wept with six families as they unlocked the doors of their brand-new homes.

## Summer Youth Blitz

### Tools for Change

The theme for the 2006 Summer Youth Blitz program was “Be the Change.” The 2006 Summer Youth Blitz program focused on equipping participants with the knowledge to bring about change in their own lives and communities.

One of the best ways to keep youth involved is to make service learning relatable to their lives. Participants were given an up-close look at how poverty housing affects their peers through discussions with homeowner children. One participant put it this way: “I just never thought about it. You see things on the news and you hear about poverty in the United States but you don’t actually see it. It was hard to have it in my face the whole time I was building, but it gave me motivation to not only complete my task, but to stay involved long after this trip is over.”

Summer Youth Blitz is a unique service experience for a diverse group of youth, ages 16 to 18, from high schools and youth organizations around the United States. During this program, 15 to 20 youth participants and adult leaders work on a Habitat house during the two weeks. In the evenings, youth participate in activities that focus on peer leadership, issues of social justice, the cycle of poverty, tolerance and team building games. The Summer Youth Blitz program works to instill the participants with a deep appreciation for diversity, awareness of substandard housing issues, and knowledge of social justice issues, and it helps create leaders who are active members of their community.

### Summer Youth Blitz 2006

- **Three hundred fifty-seven** students applied for **80** participant openings.
- **Thirty-seven** participants received full or partial scholarships.
- Participants represented **25** different states and countries including Canada, Korea, Vietnam, Germany, Peru, and St. Thomas, U.S. Virgin Islands.
- Summer Youth Blitz participants helped build **14** houses during the months of June and July.

### Summer Youth Blitz 2006 consisted of five trips:

- Slidell, Louisiana
- Sebring, Florida
- Taos, New Mexico
- Tutwiler, Mississippi
- Eagle Butte, South Dakota

The Summer Youth Blitz program grew this year! On top of the four regularly scheduled two-week Summer Youth Blitz trips, a fifth program was added to accommodate more participants.

Empowering youth to *stay* involved in service is also a focus of the Summer Youth Blitz. Participants undergo service learning discussions and meet with local community members who inspire and teach youth how to stay involved in their own communities. Mark Sturgis of the West Tallahatchie Habitat affiliate in Tutwiler, Miss., stated: "Youth need to know that they do make a difference. Physically putting tools in their hands and giving them a visual of what needs to be done is more powerful than any other message."

### Tools for Alumni

A one-week alumni trip was also added to encourage program participants to stay involved in service work. This year, 12 alumni helped raise four homes with the East St. Tammany Habitat for Humanity affiliate in Slidell, La. Alumni participants had worked on a Summer Youth Blitz within the past four years. Throughout the week-long trip, participants were able to work side by side with new homeowners, interact with homeowner youth, and participate in a discussion with the local Habitat board president. Alumni also toured the Ninth Ward district of New Orleans and got a true taste of Bayou country cooking in the French Quarter.

### Tools for Partnership

The Summer Youth Blitz Program partnered with Girls Incorporated of Alameda County, California. Girls Incorporated is a national nonprofit youth organization dedicated to the development of programming for urban youth from underserved backgrounds. Five young women from San Leandro, Calif., participated in builds in Taos, N.M., Tutwiler, Miss., Eagle Butte, S.D., and Sebring, Fla. Debbie Hernandez of Girls Incorporated stated: "...[Summer Youth Blitz] is an incredible opportunity for girls to give back to society, see and meet people from around the United States. It is such a positive opportunity that builds self-confidence while truly affecting someone else."

**The Advocacy Book: Poverty Housing** is designed for children ages 5 to 8 in a group setting, although it can be adapted and used with individuals. It is a lesson plan and interactive coloring book in which students fill in word blanks, color and draw pictures. When finished, students will have a picture book to read to friends and family. The book raises students' awareness of poverty and poverty housing on a youth-focused level at which they can relate.

## Teacher and Youth Leader Resources

### Tools for Discovery

Young people seek to discover. Their curiosity stretches from themselves, their homes and families, to their communities, and even to their world. The Youth Programs department strives to engage these impressionable youth in the mission of eliminating substandard housing. Although volunteers under the age of 16 cannot build, the Youth Programs department is dedicated to being innovative and creative in developing ways to capture their energy and help them discover the world around them. #### *Discovering the Need*

Affiliates, teachers, parents, Sunday school teachers, Girl and Boy Scout leaders, and other types of youth leaders were looking to engage youth in Habitat for Humanity's mission are continually looking for new resources. The Youth Programs department met this need in the 2005–2006 year by producing new resources as well as connecting and making previously developed resources more readily available and accessible.

#### *Discovering Advocacy*

Advocacy is more and more becoming a focus of Habitat for Humanity International and the earlier an individual is introduced to the idea, the more likely it will become part of their adult, everyday life. With this in mind, the Youth Programs department focused on developing resources to engage younger youth in advocating. Two main resources were created—the Advocacy Book and the Paper House Campaign.

#### *Discovering Faith*

As an addition to last year's Building a Better World Youth Activities Poster, a revised Leader's Guide was created to engage Christian groups. 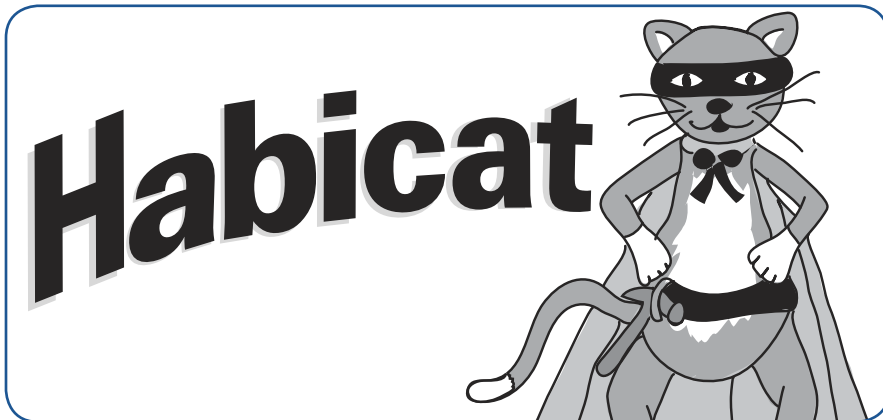
#### *Discovering Building*

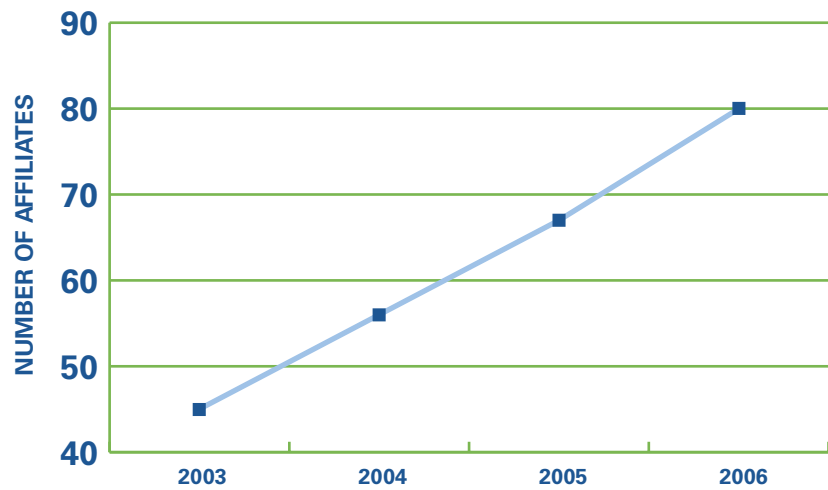
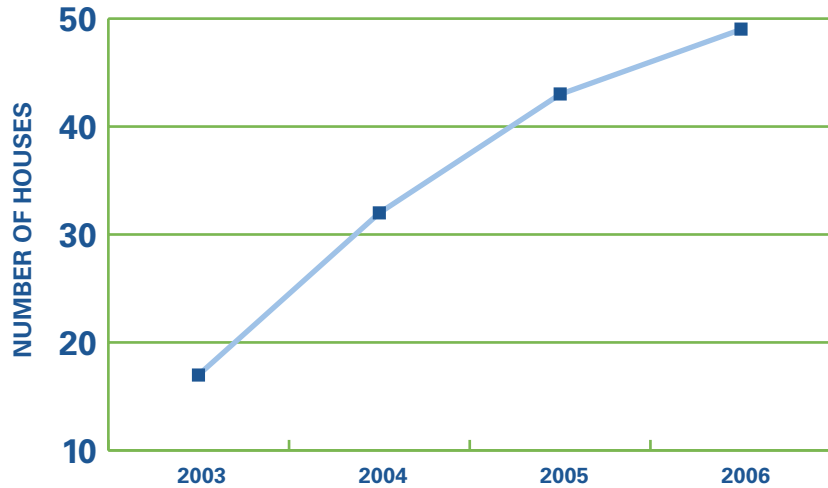

4. To increase their awareness of poverty and housing issues worldwide and in their community.

Youth United participants continue to be connected to Habitat beyond their time as Youth United volunteers in their school and local communities. Through involvement with Youth United, young people are building a brighter future for themselves and Habitat for Humanity.

Due to the increasing popularity of the program, the Youth Programs department found it necessary to increase the number of staff positions to support the program. Thanks to the National Direct grant from AmeriCorps, the Youth United staff was increased to four coordinators. Staff located around the country provide affiliates with the more personalized and immediate support.

**Grant winners**

Funded by a grant from the Argosy Foundation, seed grants have become a fixture of the Youth United program. In 2006, five matching grants of \$5,000 each were awarded to Youth United affiliates to help fund their Habitat house.

This past year, the Letter of Intent for Youth United affiliates was expanded to include participation in Act! Speak! Build! Week, Habitat's week of student advocacy for affordable housing. Youth United affiliates took part in Act! Speak! Build! Week 2006 by educating themselves and participating in a variety of activities, all focused on ending poverty housing.

#### *Youth United Training and Expo 2006*

The Youth United Training and Expo is the premier training event for Youth United affiliates. This year's Expo focused on advocacy. The Expo was held in Baltimore, Md., providing networking and training opportunities for 75 youth and adults from 18 affiliates working on Youth United projects. The workshop included: Involving the Media in Advocacy Events, Meeting with Your Local Representative, and Creative Advocacy. Representatives from the HFHI Washington office, The One Campaign, and InterAction spoke to the group to empower, equip and encourage attendees to become advocates in their community.
